## Tennessee Commission on Aging and Disability – Powerful Tools for Caregivers Intervention Class Leader Partnership Commitment Form

In June 2019 the Tennessee Commission on Aging and Disability received a 3-year Alzheimer's Disease Program Initiative (ADPI) grant from the Administration for Community Living (ACL). This grant aims to make Tennessee Dementia Capable and includes implementing an intervention for individuals with dementia and their caregivers in the five TN AAAD districts who supported the grant: Northwest, Greater Nashville, South Central, Upper Cumberland and First Tennessee. The intervention will build on the Powerful Tools for Caregivers evidence-based program by adding a music therapy component for individuals with dementia.

Powerful Tools for Caregivers caregiver classes are open to any caregivers and are not dementia specific. However, the Tennessee Commission on Aging and Disability will be providing additional support to Powerful Tools for Caregivers Class Leaders who commit to leading caregiver classes that focus on dementia and the ADPI intervention. Part of the additional support may include paying the \$200.00 Powerful Tools for Caregivers Class Leader Certification fee.
