

ORDER ELIMINATING DISTANCING REQUIREMENT


The Court hereby rescinds the requirement of any certain distance between persons in the courtroom, effective immediately. The provisions of all other orders not affected by this order remain in effect. The provisions of this order shall remain in place until further order of this Court.

It is so ORDERED.




