**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by Chair, Bob Jarnagin at 9:12 AM

**Approval of Minutes 2-15-22** – The minutes were approved with a motion from Vice Chair Huffaker and seconded by Mayor Mark Potts, all were in favor.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**Date of Proposed Jefferson County History Festival** – Secretary Hurdle brought to the attention of the committee the possibility of a conflicting event on the proposed date of October 1, 2022. The committee discussed several options including incorporating and partnering with an existing event. Mayor Potts reported he would reach out to Committee Member, Mayor Mitch Cain to see if the Celebration Committee could partner with the Mossy Creek Station Festival in Downtown Jefferson City on October 1, 2022. Two secondary options were discussed including partnering with Scots Irish Festival or doing a separate event at Glenmore Mansion.

**Review Proposed Event Budgets** – Due to changes in plans for a stand-alone event, the history festival event budget will be reviewed at a later date.

**June 11<sup>th</sup> County Commission Meeting Event** – The committee discussed the photography project. Secretary Hurdle proposed to reach out to various photographers in Jefferson County to gain quotes for photoshoots in each incorporated municipality.

**Review List of Communities and Determine Contacts** – Secretary Hurdle passed out a work sheet that listed all cities and communities within Jefferson County. The committee members discussed points of contact and will review for the next committee meeting.

**Review Press Release and Event Communications** – This item was removed from the agenda and will be discussed at a later date after the details for the history festival event have been finalized.

**New Business:**

Secretary Hurdle reported Knox County's plans for celebrating the 230<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Knox and Jefferson Counties. Knox County proposed an event to be held on a June 11<sup>th</sup> at central location. The committee decided to focus on a single Jefferson County event.

Committee Member Carmichael suggested reaching out to churches for involvement as they are the center for most of the smaller communities in Jefferson County.

Vice Chair Huffaker suggested reaching out to the Smoky Mountain Antique Tractor Association to have a display at the History Event.

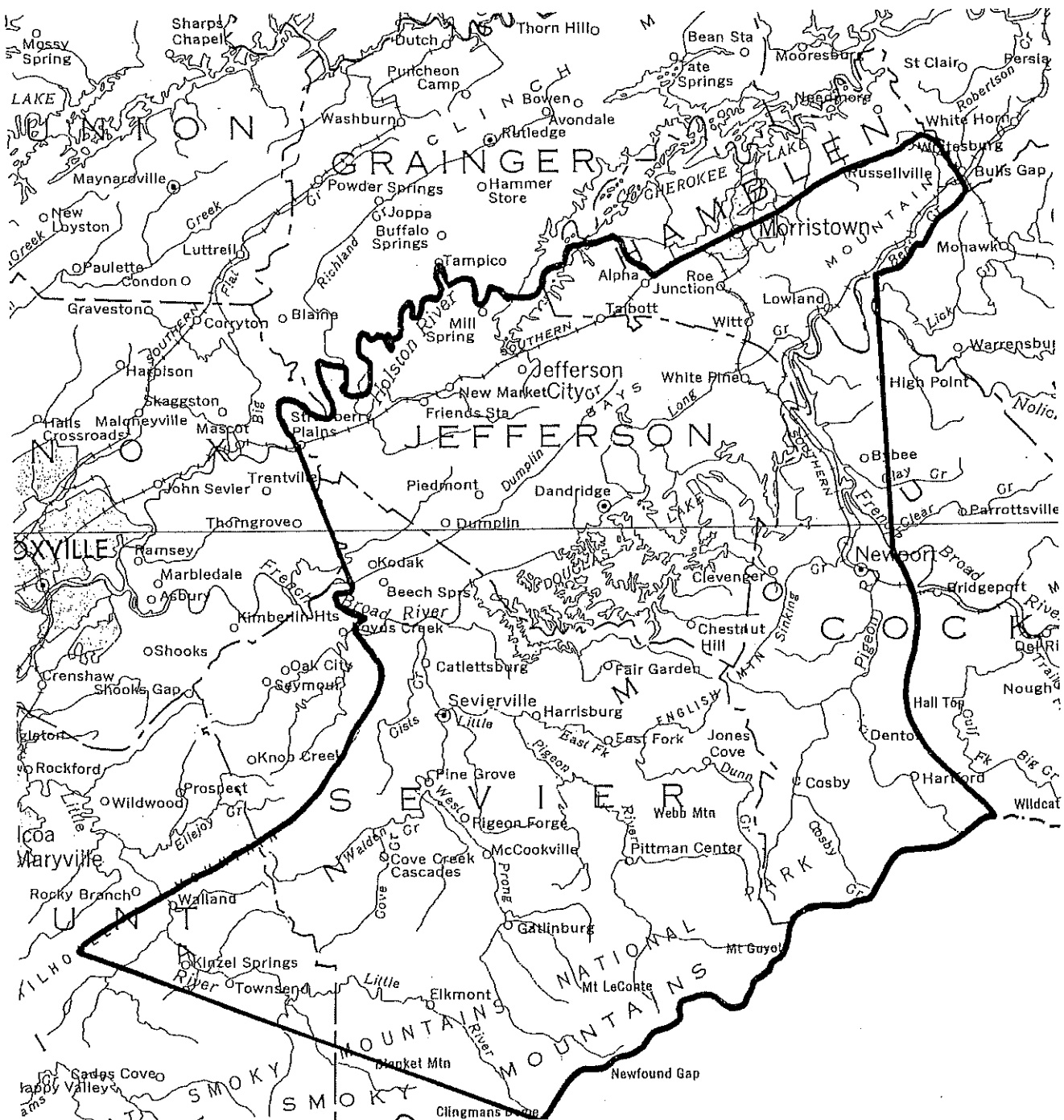

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Potts

**Election of Officers:** Motion to nominate Bob Jarnigan as Chair by Katy Huffaker, second by Mayor, Mitch Cain. Motion to nominate Terry Dockery as Vice-Chair by X, second by X. Motion to appoint Lauren Hurdle as Secretary by X, second by X. Motions passed. No opposition.

**New Business:** The committee discussed various events that would include all incorporated municipalities and all unincorporated communities including Shady Grove, Oak Grove, Piedmont, Chestnut Hill, Parrotts Chapel, Swansylvania, Kansas Talbott, Mount Horeb and Strawberry Plains in celebrating Jefferson County's 230<sup>th</sup> year of incorporation. Mitch Cain volunteered to be liason between committee and municipalities and community leaders.

Mayor Potts noted potential partnership on events and marketing with Knox County in conjunction with their 230<sup>th</sup> year.

The committee discussed preliminary budget costs that could potentially be incurred by promotion and execution of events including the development of signage, website development, logo and collateral development, cost of a commemorative quilt, and marketing and advertising. Lauren Hurdle volunteered to reach out to the Jefferson County Website developer for more information and quotes on design of webpage and logo.

The committee discussed having events throughout the county and timeframes for said events. Mayor Potts recommended a quilt made to showcase the regions of Jefferson County. Discussion continued on Jefferson County's key points of interest and assets that should be promoted by the celebration including Bush's, Carson Newman University, English Mountain Spring Water, Fishing, History and historic sites.

The committee discussed development and placement of a mural depicting Jefferson County's history and noted points of interest. Vice Chair Dockery suggested reaching out to Russel Fox Galleries for more information.
