RESOLUTION 2022-43

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JEFFERSON COUNTY TO COMMIT ADDITIONAL
FUNDING ON 2021 CDBG PROJECT # 14764 FOR EMS IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, Jefferson County previously approved Resolution 2021-09 for the CDBG application to provide match funding in the amount of \$74,118.00, and

WHEREAS, the match funding combined with the CDBG grant of \$420,000.00 brought the total amount of funding to \$494,118.00, and

WHEREAS, in order to award the low bid for ambulances to Custom Trucks and Body Works in the amount of \$184,465.00 per ambulance for a total of \$553,395.00 an additional amount of \$85,977.00 will be needed to purchase the three ambulances and meet the other line item requirements in the budget of \$25,200 administration; \$500 environmental; \$1,000 for newspaper notices for a total budget cost of \$580,095.00.

WHEREAS, the commitment from Jefferson County will be increased an additional funding amount of \$85,977.00 in order to award the low bid to Custom Trucks and Body Works in the amount of \$553,395.00; and

WHEREAS, the increase commitment will show that Jefferson County will provide a total of \$160,095.00 towards the CDBG project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Jefferson County hereby commits an additional \$85,977.00 towards the CDBG project that will increase the overall commitment of Jefferson County to \$160,095.00 and the Community Development Block Grant will commit \$420,000.00 towards the project for a total budget amount of \$580,095.00.
