LANDFILL TIPPING FEE INCREASE: \$60.00 PER TON

EFFECTIVE **MARCH 1st, 2026**

Residential Hauling – “Residential Hauling” refers to a Jefferson County citizen hauling to dispose of waste from their own primary residence where they live without the assistance of hired help. Waste from vacation homes that citizens own, which do not generate revenue, is considered residential. All trash disposal not covered under the stipulations of Residential Hauling is considered Commercial Hauling.

Commercial Hauling – “Commercial Hauling” refers to people who use the Landfill for waste disposal who are disposing waste from work they are paid to do, which makes their waste commercial waste. This includes but is not limited to rental properties, restaurants, storage units, churches, etc. All trash disposal not covered under the stipulations of Residential Hauling is considered Commercial Hauling.

Residential Load Limits: **1000lbs per day**

Any citizen who brings in a load which weighs more than the daily load limit will be charged the tipping fee for the weight of the **whole** load.

Commercial haulers will be charged the tipping fee for the weight of the whole load, **regardless of the weight.**
